



CYT Behavior Guidelines

General Guidelines

- Christian Youth Theater (CYT) is a privilege and only cooperative behavior is allowed. Respect for the Director, Area Coordinator, parents and facility representative is expected.
- Honoring language will be used. No name-calling or profanity is allowed.
- CYT students are expected to dress appropriately, modestly, and follow the CYT Dress Code.
- CYT expects students' conduct to be respectful to property. Therefore, any damage done to property intentionally will be expected to be replaced or repaired by the student.
- CYT expects purity of self in relationships with others and one's own body; therefore, drugs, alcohol, and smoking are strictly prohibited.
- Expressions of boyfriend-girlfriend type relationships between students are not appropriate at CYT activities. Overt physical contact of students is discouraged.
- CYT students Cast in a seasonal show and those who serve on Crew are expected to attend their CYT class.
- CYT wants all students to do their best and believe the Lord will do a good work in their lives.

Activities, Classroom & Showcase Guidelines

- Cell phones and electronic devices are not permitted during class time.
- Avoid unnecessary noise and distractions during class time or showcase practice.
- Stay in designated areas. CYT students may not leave the facilities at any time.
- Check in with the Class or Camp Administrator. Class students check out with Instructor.
- Students are expected to behave in a professional manner and participate in activities.
- Students are expected to arrive on time to class (Parents: pick up your children on time as well).
- If you are unable to attend class, please contact the Area Coordinator at 316-682-1688. Absences will affect Showcase casting.

Consequences (Discipline Procedures)

1. Instructor or CYT representative adult in charge will talk with the individual student about his/her misbehavior.
2. Student will be excused from activity for a period of time. Area Coordinator will discuss with parent and explain the misbehavior of the student, and the consequences of continued misbehavior.
3. If misbehavior continues, the Artistic Director will discuss with the parent and student, offering alternative behavior choices. Possible dismissal from CYT activities (camp/class/show/etc) may result.
4. Continued misbehavior will result in dismissal from all CYT activities for a particular season and dismissal from the show may result.
5. Parents and students should be aware that all misbehavior will be documented and may affect participation in future CYT activities. In certain cases, misbehavior that CYT considers extreme and/or which threatens the well being of others will result in immediate suspension and/or permanent expulsion from all CYT activities.

BEHAVIOR WILL BE DOCUMENTED AND MAY AFFECT FUTURE CYT PARTICIPATION.

Parent and student signatures on the CYT Class (or Camp) Contract represent the above Guidelines and Consequences are read and understood. Signed contracts are required prior to the first day of session and kept on file for the season.
